Background:

Historically Madison Metropolitan School District has approved a preliminary budget for the following fiscal year in April of each year. This process begins in early January, as Administration works to calculate if there will be a budget gap due to issues with state funding. From that point in time, Administration along with the Board of Education and community work to put a preliminary budget together and identify program reductions in tandem. This process has in many years created a crunch for time as decisions are made not only of the solutions for the budget gap, but for calculations for the preliminary budget as well.

Administration is recommending splitting apart the two processes identified as "budget gap solutions" and "preliminary budget approval". The recommendation would allow the Board and community the ability to work through budget gap solutions from January until May of each year, and then allow the Board and community to work through the preliminary budget approval process from May until August of each year. The separation of these two very important processes will allow Administration the ability to plan better around the biennial budget process and how it impacts Madison Schools much better going forward.
