- Just 52% of Black males and 52% of Latino males graduated on time from MMSD in 2009.
- Just 7% of Black seniors and 18% of Latino seniors were deemed "college ready" by ACT standards in 2010.



What are Charter Schools?

- Charter schools are tuitionfree, PUBLIC schools.
- Charter schools employ fully qualified teachers.
- Charter schools exist under a "contract" with a school board. This contract holds charter schools accountable for student achievement goals.
- Charter schools provide families with more options about how their students will be educated.



Madison Preparatory Academy for Young Men

- Madison Prep is a proposed all-boys charter school in MMSD opening in 2012.
- Madison Prep will serve grades 6-12 at full enrollment.
- Madison Prep will prepare all students for four-year college.
- Madison Prep will have an extended school day and year.
- Madison Prep students will wear uniforms.
- Madison Prep parents/guardians will be required to be actively involved.
- Any MMSD boy entering 6th or 7th grade may register to attend Madison Prep in 2012.
