The student climate survey was given only to students in grades 3-12, so K-2 schools do not have student data in the figures below.

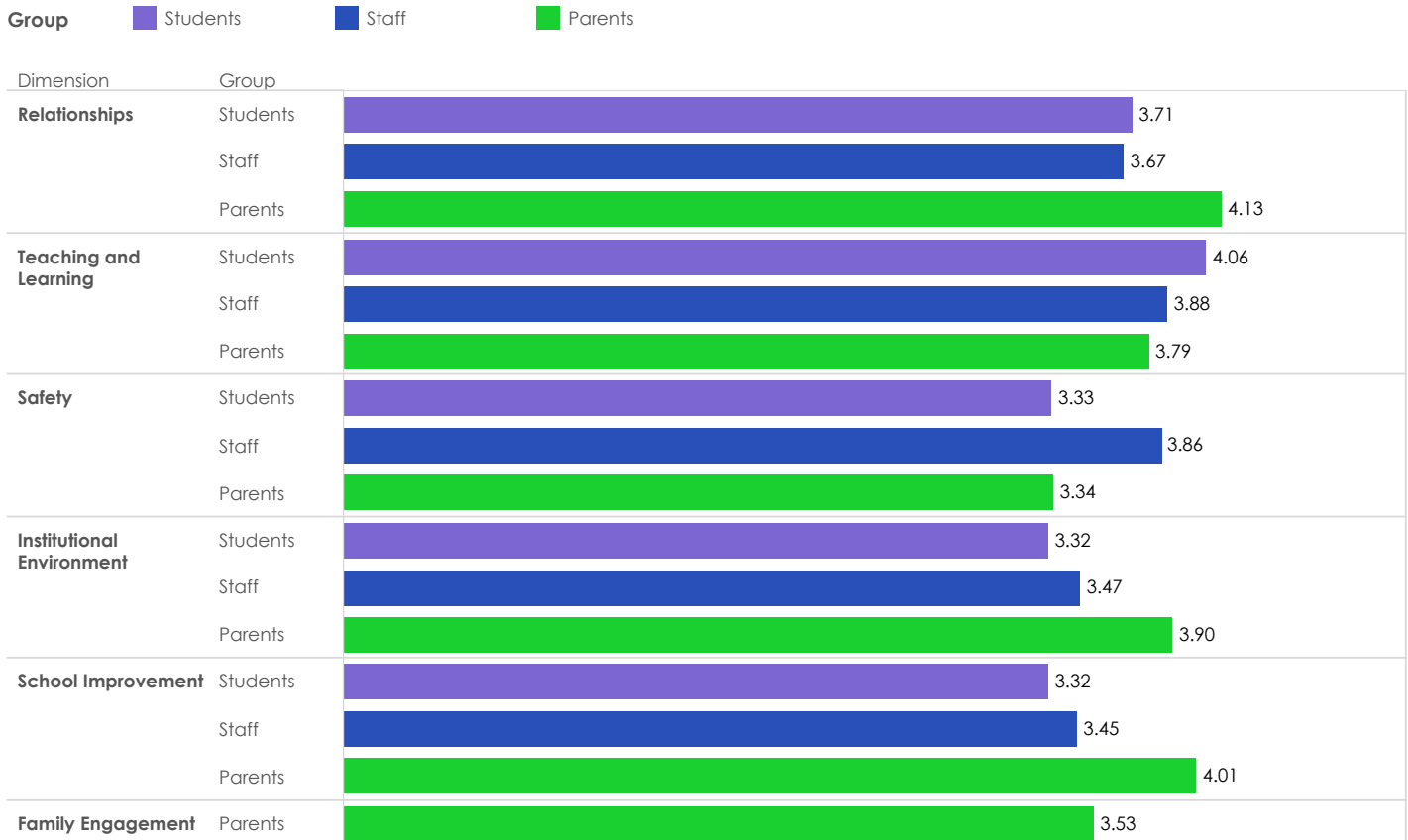
