WSAS Background

- The Wisconsin Student Assessment System (WSAS) is a comprehensive statewide assessment program designed to provide information about our students' college and career readiness.
- The assessments measure what students know in core academic areas and whether they can apply what they know.



WSAS Background

- WSAS results guide us in school improvement planning, identifying
 - where we need to focus and improve
 - where we can celebrate the growth and achievement of our students.
- WSAS results are also reported in proficiency categories and used for accountability determinations at the school, district and state levels, as the WSAS is required by state and federal laws.



WSAS Purpose

- A high-quality assessment system provides useful information
 - to parents about their child's achievement of grade-level standards
 - to educators about the success of the instruction and school's programming
 - to the public on the effectiveness of our community's school



WSAS Overview

- In 2014-15, the WSAS included:
 - The Badger Exam
 - Grades 3-8 covering ELA and mathematics
 - Grades 4 and 8 in Science, and 4, 8, and 10 in Social Studies (WKCE)
 - Dynamic Learning Maps (1%)
 - Grades 3-11 covering ELA and mathematics
 - Grades 4 and 8 11 in Science
 - Grades 4, 8, and 10 in Social Studies
 - The ACT Suite (HS)
 - ACT Aspire in Grades 9 and 10
 - The ACT + Writing in Grades 11 covering reading, English, math, science and writing
 - ACT WorkKeys in Grade 11



WSAS Participation Rates Badger/DLM

- Federal requirements are to test at least 95% of all students.
- Our overall test participation rate was 97.9% (ELA) and 96.7% (Math)
 - Our lowest-participating subgroup's test participation rate was 94.9% (Special Education – Math)
- This compares to 2013-14 rate of >95%



Test Participation Rate Badger/DLM








Overall Performance ELA (Badger/DLM)






Student Performance by Gender **ELA (Badger/DLM)**



Student Performance by Ethnicity ELA (Badger/DLM)








Student Performance by ELL ELA (Badger/DLM)













Student Performance by Disability ELA (Badger/DLM)






Overall Performance Math (Badger/DLM)






Student Performance by Gender Math (Badger/DLM)




Student Performance by Ethnicity Math (Badger/DLM)






Student Performance by ELL Math (Badger/DLM)






Student Performance by Grade Math (Badger/DLM)






Student Performance by Disability Math (Badger/DLM)

ACT Background

- The ACT consists of five subject tests
 - English, reading, writing, math and science
- For reporting and accountability purposes, student performance is reported for ELA and mathematics.
 - ELA scores are comprised of the English, reading, and writing subtests




Participation Rates ACT/DLM

- Federal requirements are to test at least 95% of all students.
- Our overall test participation rate was 98.2% (ELA) and 99.3% (Math)
 - Our lowest-participating subgroup's test participation rate was 95.1% (SWD)
- This compares to 2013-14 rate of >95%




Test Participation Rate ACT/DLM






Overall Performance ELA (ACT/DLM)






Student Performance by Gender ELA (ACT/DLM)






Student Performance by Ethnicity ELA (ACT/DLM)






Student Performance by ELL ELA (ACT/DLM)






Student Performance by Disability ELA (ACT/DLM)






Student Performance by Economics ELA (ACT/DLM)






Overall Performance Math (ACT/DLM)






Student Performance by Gender Math (ACT/DLM)






Student Performance by Ethnicity Math (ACT/DLM)






Student Performance by ELL Math (ACT/DLM)
