

#### **Parents Want Data**

87% use data to make decisions about their child's education

91% of parents who do not have information about whether their child is on track to graduate wish they did 9 of 10 parents say they rely on data to understand how their child is progressing in school


Parents largely trust those closest to students to appropriately use data.

91% of parents trust their child's teacher to use data appropriately

Parents who currently receive information about their child




## **State Landscape**

Number of States with Each State Action: 2011 and 2014





Strategies for transparency about data use, storage, retention, destruction, and protection 5. Statewide policies governing personally identifiable information

6. Statewide data security plan



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
