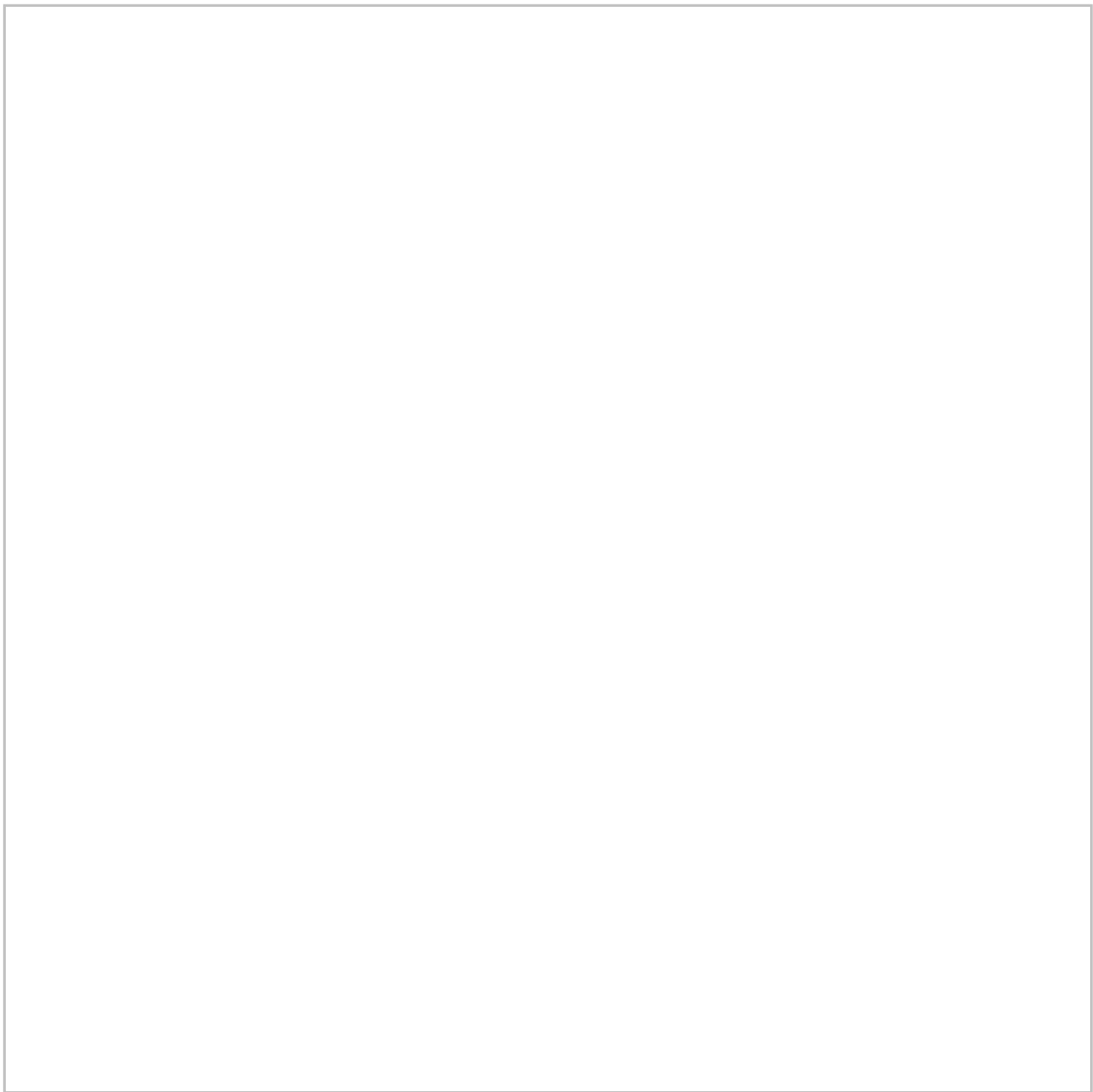
cherry harvest. There's still some left!

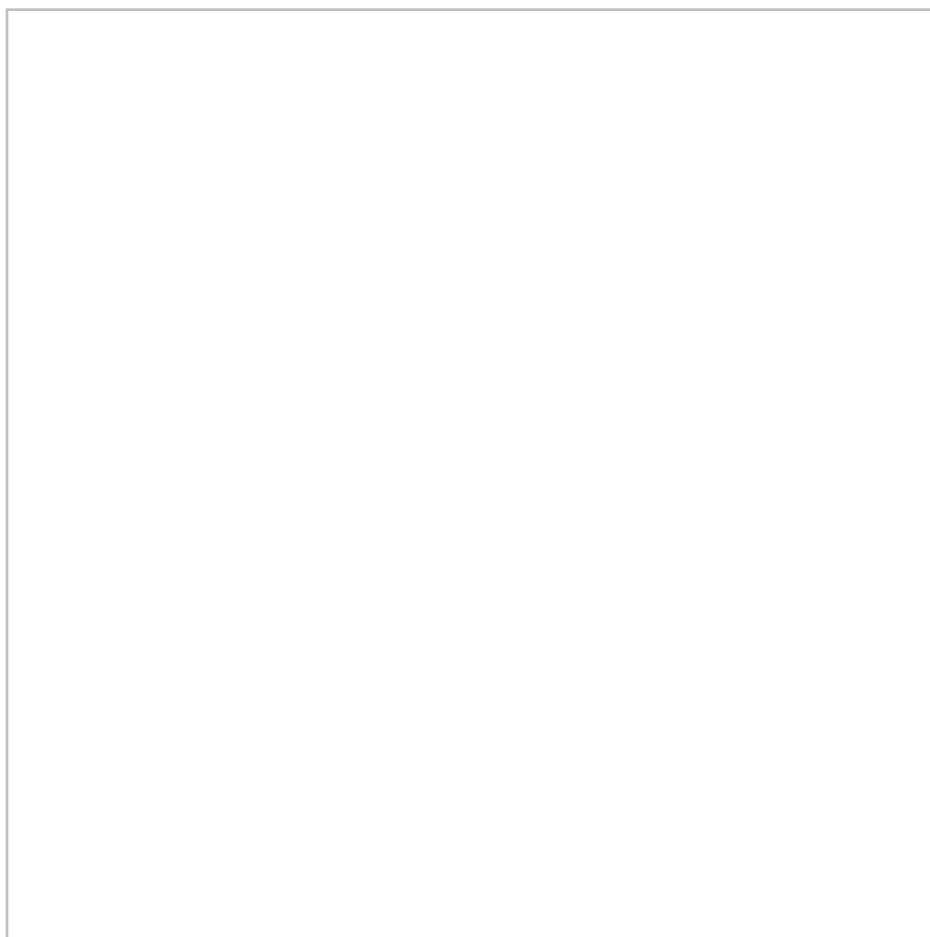
## FIJI Fraternity Work Day (9/19/21)
